Committee Charter

As an Advisory Committee, **QEMSAC will:**

1. Engage representatives from the community, System service providers, and clinical and operational specialists within the System, at a State, Zone and District level, to evaluate system effectiveness.
2. Identify opportunities for system improvement by monitoring trends in system data, clinical audit reports and adverse patient outcome reports.
3. Advise the Ministers for Health and Emergency Services of system deficiencies and provide recommendations on system improvement.
4. Report annually *to relevant Ministers* on the Committee's outputs.

As members of QEMSAC **we:**

1. Actively participate in QEMS processes by critically reviewing submissions and briefs placed before QEMSAC.
2. Monitor the performance of Working Groups; encourage innovation and ensure timely and comprehensive attention to QEMS strategies.

As a member of QEMSAC **I will:**

1. Participate in QEMS Working Groups, provide leadership, and where nominated, be a communication conduit between QEMSAC and a nominated project team.
2. Contribute to the development of QEMS strategies from knowledge and experience gained through professional and community networks.
3. Encourage innovation in the development of policy advice with a focus on coordinated delivery of emergency health services and the integration of service delivery agencies.

As a member of QEMSAC **I bring:**

1. Clinical, professional and community experience which enables objective consideration of issues and the development of informed and balanced strategic advice.
